The Institute for American Indian Research (IFAIR) at the University of New Mexico (UNM) announces Faculty and Graduate Student Summer Research Awards.

**Eligibility Criteria**: All faculty applicants must hold tenure-track or tenured full-time appointments in a UNM department or academic program. Graduate students must be in good standing and have completed twelve credit hours of graduate courses.

#### **Submission Information:**

Applicants should submit the following materials in a single file (.doc/x or .PDF, please) in the following order:

- 1. A cover page with current contact information (department affiliation, degree status, campus mail address, e-mail address, and telephone number)
- 2. A two-page proposal clearly explaining in non-specialist language: the focus of the research project; its theoretical groundings in Native/Indigenous research; its connection to IFAIR's mission; and how the funds will be used to advance your work (single-spaced, 12-point type). Additionally, your proposal should indicate how your research is supportive of and supported by Indigenous Nations, communities, or peoples.
- 3. A detailed budget outlining research and travel expenses. Please indicate other funding sources pursued (pending or awarded).
- 4. A brief two-page CV
- 5. A letter from your advisor indicating your readiness to conduct research for your project <u>(For Graduate students only)</u>
